


Navigating the StreetAccount Site

Select "Real-Time News" to access All Headlines. Portfolio Headlines, Sector Headlines, Regional Headlines, ESG Headlines, My Headlines, Overnight Snapshot, and Up/ Downgrades.

Use the Search field to search StreetAccount news by ticker, company name, or keyword.

Access additional options from the left pane, allowing you to filter your research, select date ranges, choose search options, and more depending on your view.






Creating a Portfolio


1. Select "My Portfolios" from the My Account drop-down menu.




- 2. Click the Create A New Portfolio button to enter in your tickers or choose from StreetAccount's Country and Index Portfolios.
- 3. Type the tickers into the numbered fields or click the Copy/Paste/Import button to paste in tickers from a spreadsheet. Create up to 40 portfolios, with 500 tickers each.



4. Click the "advanced options" link to change alert settings. Real-time alerts will be received by default; however, you can reduce the number of alerts by selecting a batched option.



5. Click the Save button to create your portfolio. After saving, you can easily view the coverage you can expect from Street Account for your tickers.



6. To view Portfolio Headlines within the site, go to Real-Time News > Portfolio Headlines. You can filter on the portfolio you just created in the left pane.




Creating a Custom Sector

1. Go to My Account > My Sectors




- 2. Click the Create A New Custom Sector button, and then name the sector.
- 3. Select the sector/industries you want to include. You can press the CTRL key or click and drag to select more than one at a time
- 4. Use the >> to add the sector/industries into the Custom Sector section
- 5. Make region selections and set market cap ranges.
- 6. (Optional) Select the "Email Alert" check box to receive alerts
- 7. Click the "options" link next to the Email Alert check box to customize the alert settings. You can choose from realtime or batched alerts, select news categories, and set exclusions.
- 8 Click Save when finished
- 9. To view Sector Headlines within the site, go to Real-Time News > Sector Headlines. You can filter on the sector you just created in the left pane.



Viewing News Headlines


Select the Real-Time News drop-down menu and choose from the available menu options to target the news to your interests. Use the News Filters in the left pane to narrow your search to a number of default views, including Earnings, M&A, and Street Takeaways that summarize broker comments following major news events. You can also create custom filters that allow you to see only the news that's relevant to you.





Accessing Today's Top News

Select Top News > Today's Top News to quickly get familiar with the market conversation within various regions and sectors. It includes a market synopsis, top stories, live headlines, economic/events calendar, and most-clicked third party links. Today's Top News is constantly monitored and updated by StreetAccount analysts, so the content is never stale.





Select Market Pulse > Gainers & Decliners to view a snapshot of trading data with clear rationale behind the day's most significant stock moves.







Themes






Accessing Calendars

Use StreetAccount web to stay up-to-date on all company events using the following calendars: Earnings, Farnings Preannouncements, Events, Syndicate, Economic, and Conference Presentations. You can also narrow the focus of each calendar by applying filters, including portfolio, region, content, and other criteria depending on the calendar selected.

Daily View


The Earnings Calendar allows you to see which companies are reporting earnings on which date. Choose Calendars > Earnings to launch the calendar. Choose to view data in list or calendar format.





Using Syndicate Calendars


Track new stock offerings with the Syndicate calendar by selecting Calendars > Syndicate. You can view the company, type of syndicate, lead underwriters, share, and price information.





Viewing Industry Data: Drug Database

StreetAccount's Drug Database provides relevant and current information on prescription drugs and biologics, as well as pipeline candidates. Search by ticker, company name, drug name, class of drug, indication or application number. You can access it by going to Industry Data > Drug Database
